Recommendations:

That the Committee of the Whole recommends to Regional Council:

- A) That three members of Council be appointed to participate on the Strategic Plan Development Task Force as outlined in this report, to guide the process of developing a new Durham Region Strategic Plan; and
- B) That staff be directed to bring forward the new Durham Region Strategic Plan at the November 13, 2019 Committee of the Whole meeting.

Report:

1. Purpose

1.1 The purpose of this report is to make recommendations regarding the formation of a Task Force to oversee the development of a new strategic plan for the Regional Municipality of Durham.

2. Background

- 2.1 At the Finance and Administration Committee orientation meeting of January 15, 2019, Council directed staff to initiate a process to develop a new strategic plan.
- 2.2 A full day Special Council Meeting has been planned for March 21, 2019 where all Regional Councillors will have the opportunity to contribute to the development of the plan through a discussion of Council priorities for the term. An external facilitator has been retained to guide this process.

3. Task Force Role and Composition

- 3.1 Consistent with the process followed in 2015, staff recommends the formation of a Task Force to guide the development of the new strategic plan.
 - a. The role of the Task Force is to:
 - Approve the project timeline;
 - Discuss the timeframe for the plan (4 or 5-year plan);
 - Determine the scope of public consultation and mechanisms for input;
 - Attend public meetings, where possible;
 - Periodically review progress of the plan;
 - Provide input on updates for Regional Council; and
 - Review draft plan and make suggestions prior to full Council consideration.
- 3.2 Staff recommends that the composition of the Task Force include the CAO and one Department Head as staff representatives, along with three Regional Councillors. The Director of Corporate Policy and Strategic Initiatives will support the Task Force and serve as the liaison between the external facilitator and the committee.

4. Conclusion

- 4.1 To begin the strategic planning process, the formation of the Task Force is essential.
- 4.2 Staff recommends that the Task Force identified in this report be formed to guide the process of developing a new Durham Region Strategic Plan.
