In follow-up to the February 16, 2023, DECAC meeting minutes with respect to concerns raised by S. Clearwater regarding the number of significant drinking water threats (SDWTS) identified in the 2022 Source Water Protection Annual Report, she advised that she followed up with staff who clarified the process, and advised that many homes that were estimated to be on a well, turned out to be on gas/septic so they were eliminated that way and the number was eventually brought down to 0.

## 5. Presentation

# A) Envision Durham – Draft Regional Official Plan, Aneesah Luqman, Senior Planner

Aneesah Luqman, Senior Planner, provided a PowerPoint Presentation regarding the Envision Durham – Draft Regional Official Plan.

Concerns were raised regarding the difficulty in identifying Kettle Lake from the other evaluated wetlands on Map 2C because of the similarity in colours; and on

Map 2G, what the reason is for the highly vulnerable aquifers being found mostly on the Oak Ridges Moraine, and whether other areas would also be vulnerable.

A. Luqman responded to questions from the Committee regarding the definitions of "Natural Core Areas" (referenced on Map 2B), "Complex Landform and Moderately Complex Landform" (referenced on Map 2H). She advised that she would look into the definitions of Natural Core Areas, Complex Landform, and Moderately Complex Landform for the Committee. She also reminded the Committee to submit any additional comments on the final Draft Official Plan by April 3, 2023.

## 6. Items for Discussion

A) 2023-P-6: Envision Durham – Release of the Draft New Regional Official Plan – Draft Plan and Map Viewer

A copy of Report #2023-INFO-16 of the Commissioner of Works was received.

- S. Clearwater raised concerns regarding the use of pesticides being absent from Report #2023-INFO-16 of the Commissioner of Works, but that pesticides are referenced in Report #2023-P-6 of the Commissioner of Planning & Economic Development. She stated that Report #2023-INFO-16 only references the use of herbicides and insecticides, but dimethoate is mentioned in the testing sheet and that it should be identified as a pesticide to make it more accurate. S. Clearwater asked if the other 7 neonicotinoids are being used in the Region because they only test for dimethoate. A. Luqman asked that S. Clearwater forward her the list of all neonicotinoids so that she could follow-up with the appropriate staff and report back to her directly.
- C) Commissioner's Report #2023-WR-1: Update on the Proposed Clear Garbage Bag Pilot in the Municipality of Clarington

It was the consensus of the Committee to hear a presentation from the Works department regarding the Organics Management Plan at a future DECAC meeting.
