What is the Oak Ridges Moraine?

The Oak Ridges Moraine is a ridge of land that runs parallel to and about 60 km north of Lake Ontario. It extends about 200 km from the Niagara Escarpment in the west to the Trent River in the east.

One of the most significant features of the Moraine is the groundwater which results from rainwater percolation into the generally porous soils of the Morain e. The Moraine forms the watershed divide between Lake Ontario and Lake Simcoe and is the headwaters to more than 30 rivers.
