#### What is Hannukah (Chanukah)?

Chanukah is the Jewish eight-day, wintertime "festival of lights," celebrated with a nightly menorah lighting, sp ecial prayers and fried foods.

The Hebrew word <u>Chanukah</u> means "dedication," and is thus named because it celebrates the rededication of the Holy Temple (as you'll read below). Also spelled Hanukkah (or variations of that spelling), the Hebrew word is actually pronounced with a guttural, "kh" sound, kha-nu-kah, not tcha-new-kah.

In the second century BCE, the Holy Land was ruled by the Seleucids (Syrian-Greeks), who tried to force the pe ople of Israel to accept Greek culture and beliefs instead of mitzvah observance and belief in God. Against all o dds, a small band of faithful but poorly armed Jews, led by Judah the Maccabee, defeated one of the mightiest ar mies on earth, drove the Greeks from the land, reclaimed the Holy Temple in Jerusalem and rededicated it to the service of God.

When they sought to light the Temple's <u>Menorah</u> (the seven-branched candelabrum), they found only a single cr use of olive oil that had escaped contamination by the Greeks. Miraculously, they lit the menorah and the one-d ay supply of oil lasted for eight days, until new oil could be prepared under conditions of ritual purity.

To commemorate and publicize these miracles, the sages instituted the festival of Chanukah.
